#### **Principles of Control**

**Pressure** – slow or stop the flow of blood. Squeeze wound edges together and wrap the injury.



**Elevation** – blood flows poorly uphill. Lift bleeding area and keep it raised.

#### What to do



## External bleeding





- Elevate wounded area, if possible.
- Apply bandage over pad. If blood soaks through, use another pad and more bandaging.
- Apply a sling, if possible.
- Call 000 for ambulance/medical help.
- Check blood flow present beyond dressing.





## Internal bleeding

- DRSABCD
- Lay casualty down to prevent fainting.
- Raise casualty's feet by 20 cm or so, if possible.
- Call 000 for ambulance/medical help.
